In FSH210, students embark on a creative odyssey, merging the skills that they have honed in design, construction, draping, and flat patternmaking to create a personal collection. This intensive workshop culminates in presenting five original designs at our annual fashion show, offering students a platform to showcase their talent and step into the professional world. This course is not just about learning; it's about launching your signature style in the fashion industry.
